
# THE WALDORF= ASTORIA PARIS



**Above:** View of reception area through marble clad entry hallway


**Right:** Historic etchings of existing central staircase.

The Grand Hall is once again the central gathering point in the hotel, situated adjacent to the main historic staircase.












Above: View of terrace adjacent to grand ballroom








Above: View of roof garden with Eiffel Tower in background.
